This spring, awarding over **\$145,415** in grant funding to **15** local community organizations is like planting seeds in the rich soil of our community — the community foundation hopes that each of these grants will nurture growth, collaboration, and empowerment in these organizations.

These funds not only help organizations thrive but also cultivate a vibrant sense of community spirit; all working together to support our residents.

We are thrilled that **since 2003** the community foundation has distributed over **\$4.95 million** in grant funding to 74 community organization to support approximately **513** vital projects!

## Congratulations to the 2025 Grant Recipients!

The following **Community Impact Grants** are funded from our Campbellford/Seymour Community Fund:

- Aron Theatre Cooperative Inc. in partnership with Innresponse a \$4,750 grant to purchase two laptops and one desktop computer for use in the theatre.
- Campbellford and District Curling and Racquet Club a \$4,743 grant to purchase fitness equipment a Hoist Dual Thigh/Outer Thigh HD-3800 so that their fitness facility can remain competitive.
- Inclusion Northumberland a \$5,000 grant to upgrade the Campbellford Community Resource Centre website to make it more user friendly.
- Incredible Edibles Festival Inc. in partnership with Innresponse a \$5,000 grant to create an online Local Food Connection Map to showcase the full spectrum of food producers in Trent Hills.
- Kent Public School in partnership with KPRDSB a \$4,590.81 grant to purchase 9 Chromebooks for student use, to replace outdated ones.
- St. Mary Catholic Elementary School in partnership with PVNCCDSB a \$5,000 grant to purchase flexible seating and workspaces to increase availability for all students in the school community.
- Westben Arts Festival Theatre\_- a \$5,000 grant to support the creation of a "yellow brick road" which will be surrounded by a semi-wild food forest. This project is in conjunction with the 2025 production of the Wizard of Oz.



We also awarded the following community impact grants with partial funding coming from our other established funds:

- Campbellford Memorial Hospital a \$5,000 grant towards the purchase of the Tovertafel program, which will contribute to a better quality of life of patients living with dementia. (Includes \$250 from the Glover Family Fund)
- Friends of the Campbellford/Seymour Carnegie Library a \$5,000 grant for their Library Courtyard Restoration Project. The fence will be repaired and a mural painted on the fence with the help of Artworth camp participants. (Includes \$3,500 from the Ontario Endowment for Children & Youth in Recreation Fund).
- Hillcrest Public School in partnership with KPRDSB a \$5,000 grant towards the purchase of the National Archery in Schools Program. (Includes \$3,504 from the Ontario Endowment for Children & Youth in Recreation Fund).
- Rotary Club of Campbellford a grant of \$2,443 to go towards the installation of a water fountain/water bottle refill station in Kennedy Park. (Includes \$500 from the Environmental Fund).
- St. Paul's United Church, Warkworth Artworth is celebrating their 20th anniversary in 2025. St. Paul's has been the base for the camp for 18 years and is receiving a grant of \$2,927.70 to host an anniversary event in their honour. (Includes \$500 from the Northumberland Arts & Culture Fund).



Four **Job Opportunity for Youth (JOY)** grants were awarded from our Campbellford/ Seymour Community Fund and one from our Ontario Endowment for Children & Youth in Recreation Fund (OECYR).

This grant program provides students with an opportunity to learn about charitable and not-for-profit organizations, as well as develop skills for future employability.

- Artworth Trent Hills Arts & Nature Camp in partnership with Innresponse a \$4,760 grant to hire two students for a 4-week placement as Assistant Camp Coordinators. (Full funding from the OECYR Fund).
- Campbellford Memorial Hospital Foundation a \$5,000 grant to hire a student for an 8-week placement as a Foundation Assistant.
- Community Care Northumberland a \$5,000 grant to hire a student for an 8-week placement as an Student Office Administrator.
- Incredible Edibles Festival Inc. in partnership with Innresponse a \$5,000 grant to hire a student for an 18-week part-time placement as a Marketing Assistant.
- Rotary Club of Campbellford a \$5,000 grant to hire a student for an 11-week placement as a Canteen Operator at Kennedy Park.

As of 2025, 91 students will have had the benefit of gaining on the job experience through this grant initiative.





Grant funding in the amount of \$66,200.50 from the **Campbellford/Seymour Municipal Fund** was awarded to the Municipality of Trent Hills as part of the \$1.5 million commitment made through *Flourish* ~ *The Trent Hills Wellness Campaign.* 

The funding supports the new Sunny Life Recreation and Wellness Centre in Campbellford.
